Pentecost is the day we celebrate the arrival of the Holy Spirit to the early church, as well as the gifts of the Holy Spirit to the church and the world today!

Gloria Patri (Latin for “Glory be to the Father”) is an ancient prayer of praise. Early Christians usually referred to God in masculine terms. You might sing “Mother” or “Creator” instead of “Father,” depending on how you think about God.

The Lord’s Prayer is a prayer that Jesus taught his disciples. We say this prayer together each week. It asks God to help us be generous, thankful, and humble.

Today’s anthem is a setting of Ephesians 4:30–32. T. Tertius Noble is best known for his edition of Handel’s “Messiah” and a volume of free organ accompaniments to 100 hymn tunes still used today.

Doxology is Greek for “words of glory.” We use this ancient form of praise to thank God as the offering is brought forward with the bread and juice for the Lord’s Supper.

You can find today’s scripture reading on page 119 of the New Testament in your pew Bible.

The Lord’s Supper (also called Communion) is a celebration of Christ’s love for the world and a remembrance of his death and resurrection. We share this meal each week and **everyone** is welcome to participate.
