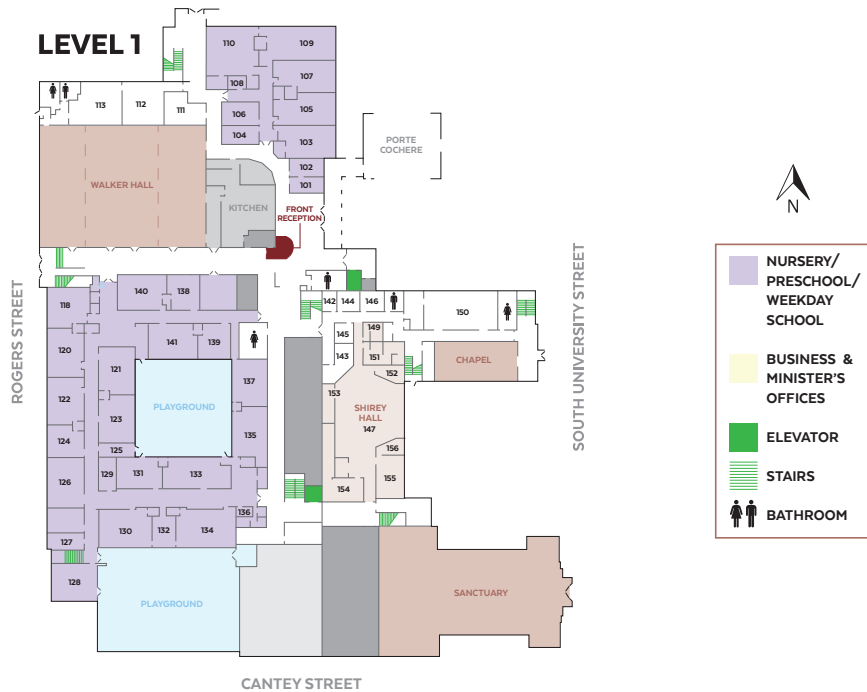


Building Map

Sunday School Class Descriptions

Biblical Storytelling

UCC's own Barbara Tucker is a certified Storyteller with the Network of Biblical Storytellers. The first Sunday of each month she will be presenting Bible stories for people of all ages as a way to help people engage with scripture in a different way. All are welcome

College

A place to connect with other students and discuss faith, culture, vocation and the Bible as we look at how to navigate life as people of faith.

Common Ground

A Bible study led by a class members, the group focuses on one book of the Bible at a time. This is a great opportunity for adults looking to dive into scripture.

Community

A group for young professionals looking for community and fellowship while seeking the sacred. A fun and casual group focused on service, connecting and building relationships.

Connections

A class for adults with special needs—our goal is to encourage spiritual development and strengthen ties within the faith community. Meets 2nd and 4th Sundays.

Faithful Families

A class primarily of families with young children, though all are welcome. We discuss a variety of topics and seek ways to keep our faith at the center of family life.

Kaleidoscope

This new class has vibrant discussions about a variety of topics

Genesis

A class of adults of varying ages who support each other spiritually and socially on the journey of faith.

Harmony

A teacher-led, 30 minute class. We discuss the hymns and anthems sung in worship each week, looking at their history and how they impact our journey of faith.

Koinonia

A class for adults of all ages, we discuss family issues, spiritual development, and how to be better Christian servants through speakers, discussion, literature and film.

Logos

A multigenerational group, led by a variety of speakers, discussing how to be Christian in today's world.

Peoples Bible Class

A Bible based, lecture style class for adults of all ages. The class is taught by a variety of biblical scholars, authors, and local religious leaders.
